

Predicted Dates for Jehovah God's Holy Days for 2021

This may be Year 6025 After Creation.

All four potential New Moons for the coming New Biblical Year are clear-cut, and should be easily visible in a clear sky. However, as always, we are dependent on the observation of Abib barley in Israel to determine which month begins the New Year. We will keep you updated as information on this comes in.

If this spring's barley harvest is early, these should be the Holy Days for Israel and regions westward to the International Date Line:

Abib 1 begins at dusk on Sunday, 14 Mar 2021 CE

The Passover Preparation Day begins at dusk on Saturday, 27 Mar 2021 CE

The Last Supper is the evening of Saturday, 27 Mar 2021 CE

The Passover Sacrifice is offered on the afternoon of Sunday, 28 Mar 2021 CE

The First Day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, a Holy Day, begins at dusk on Sunday, 28 Mar and ends at dusk on Monday, 29 Mar 2021 CE

The Night of Solemn Observance begins after dusk on Sunday, 28 Mar 2021 CE

The Wave Offering (the First-fruit) is on the morning of Sunday, 4 Apr 2021 CE

The Last Day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, a Holy Day, begins at dusk on Saturday, 3 Apr and ends at dusk on Sunday, 4 Apr 2021 CE

First-fruits (Pentecost) begins at dusk on Saturday, 22 May and ends at dusk Sunday, 23 May 2021 CE
